 Provide accurate picture of current air quality, including challenges and successes, which provide a foundation for future air quality improvement strategies






Community Workshop Series

- Distributed electronically through APCD lists, social media, partner programs, peer agencies, community groups, any and all avenues









































Workshop Planning

Clearing the Air Workshop Series


The APCD Workshop Series seeks to:


