- <u>Principles for Addressing Environmental Justice Concerns in Air</u> <u>Permitting</u> (December 2022)
- Supports EPA regions to take immediate action to address EJ concerns as part of EPA's implementation of air permitting programs
- Encourages EPA regions to share the principles with Tribal, state, and local partners and to work proactively and collaboratively with those partners to facilitate consideration and application of these principles in their air permitting actions.
- Encourages examining all relevant statutory and regulatory authorities, including discretionary authorities to address or mitigate identified air quality impacts to the extent feasible. References *EPA Legal Tools to Advance Environmental Justice*.
- Addresses Title VI requirements by referencing Interim Environmental Justice and Civil Rights in Permitting Frequently Asked Questions ("FAQ")

Principles for Addressing EJ Concerns in Air Permitting 1. Identify communities

2. Engage early

3. Enhance public involvement

4. Fit-for-purpose analysis

5. Minimize and mitigate

6. Provide federal support

7. Enhance transparency

## State/Local Examples

Universal Coatings
Michigan EGLE, Minor NSR Permit

- Agreement on further VOC and HAP reductions.
- Suncor Energy, Plant 1 and 3 Refinery Colorado Dept of Public Health & Environment, Title V Permit Renewal
  - CDPHE webpage with up-to-date information on the refinery
  - Facility website to disseminate CEM data for transparency

#### SOBE Thermal Energy Systems

Ohio EPA, Minor NSR Permit

- Ohio EPA EJ report
- Dispersion modeling to demonstrate NO2, PM2.5 NAAQS compliance

#### Carmeuse Lime

Indiana Dept of Environmental Management, Title V Permit Renewal

- Clarifications on the use of engineered fuels
- Covanta Delaware Valley Pennsylvania DEP, Title V Permit Renewal
  - PADEP source-specific community information webpage
  - Additional actions taken by the source (e.g., website posting CEM data)









### U.S. EPA Example

#### Veolia ES Technical Solutions - Hazardous Waste Incinerator

U.S. EPA Region 5, Title V (Part 71) Permit Renewal

#### **Early Community Engagement Meeting**

Held prior to the public comment period to:

- Explain the air permit and emissions
- Receive community feedback on:
  - What would effective community engagement look like to residents?
  - What environmental concerns should EPA consider while drafting the permit?
- Feedback period requesting community input, ends May 15
  - In person, email, QR code
- Share Veolia contact information for facility tours, if interested

#### **EPA Public Participation Plan**

• Expected issuance July 15

Early engagement by the applicant to proactively identify and mitigate concerns

#### **Examples of Applicant Actions**

- Conducting their own early engagement (pre-application) with the community to understand their concerns
- Proactively assessing EJ concerns and preparing an EJ analysis
- Identifying measures they can take to mitigate impacts
- Developing a facility webpage to provide community information
- Attending permit public information meetings and public hearings

### Title VI of the Civil Rights Act: Informal Resolution Agreements

An Informal Resolution Agreement (IRA) is a set of voluntary commitments aimed at resolving Title VI complaints accepted for investigation by U.S. EPA.
