Planning Grants



PROGRAM GOALS



Implement ambitious measures that will achieve significant cumulative greenhouse gas (GHG) reductions by 2030 and beyond



Achieve substantial community benefits (such as reduction of criteria and hazardous air pollutants), particularly in low-income and disadvantaged communities



Complement other funding sources to maximize these GHG reductions and community benefits



Pursue innovative policies and programs that are replicable and can be "scaled up" across multiple jurisdictions






TRIBES AND TERRITORIES COMPETITION

Climate Planning: In all States and Territories 96% of U.S. population covered by Climate Action Plans






PLANNING GRANTEES

Additional Planning Grantees

- 4 territories
- 90 Tribes and Tribal consortia (covering ~225 Tribes)





PLANNING GRANTS

- Comprehensive Climate Action Plans (CCAPs) due December 1, 2025 (or later)
- In-person workshop for planning grantees September 4-6 in Minneapolis, MN to provide technical assistance in support of CCAP development and peer networking opportunities
- Technical Assistance Forums on planning-related topics will continue to meet monthly to support grantees
